notes

built as an “everyday” drinker, this blend is heavy on tempranillo (with zinfandel helping to round things out). dominated by red fruit (cherry and raspberry), spice and a little vanilla. soft tannins (from the tempranillo) and sweet fruit (courtesy of the zin) draw out the finish.
