notes

if lodi had a heritage grape (that wasn't zinfandel), it would absolutely be carignane. the intense color and dark fruit grab you right out of the gate (as you might expect from a vineyard that's 65-years old). the fruit continues to call the shots on the palate - but is nicely balanced by dirt, subtle oak and soft tannins.
